Highway Projects, an inter-denominational Christian organization, works towards reconciliation between all peoples in the Middle East, and believes that the best expression of Christian love in the Holy Lands is through acts of practical love. The main emphasis of our work is amongst disadvantaged people from across the religious divide, especially amongst the Arab community.

Highway Projects is a volunteer based organization, which offers an opportunity for short-term project work in the Middle East. Trips of 14-16 days are arranged for both July and September. Volunteers need to be committed Christians, aged 18+ years old and are expected to cover their own fees, which pay for all transport, accommodation, induction and tours whilst overseas.

In 2005 we undertook seven projects - project work included practical painting and decorating, caring work with the elderly, building renovation, summer camps for disabled Muslim children, holiday clubs for Christian teenagers, discipleship camps for young adults.
